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OTHER INCENTIVE PROGRAMS UPDATE

CAP INCENTIVE PROGRAM PROJECTED TIMELINE

April/May/June/July

- Clean Air Grant Solicitation period April 1 – May 30
- Conduct a “This is Your Air District” community meeting
- Receive CARB notification of CAP grant award

Aug/Sept/Oct

- Receive and execute CAP Grant Agreement
- Review waitlist, conduct 2nd solicitation if necessary

November/December

- Request CAP funding from CARB. May not receive until 2022.

WOODSMOKE REDUCTION INCENTIVE PROGRAM

- 55 PROJECTS APPROVED FOR FUNDING SINCE AUGUST 2020
- WAITING LIST FOR EPA TAG GRANT STARTED – EXPECT FUNDING SUMMER
- LOOKING FOR FUNDING OUTSIDE FEDERAL PM NON-ATTAINMENT AREA
- ONGOING PARTNERSHIP WITH EL DORADO AQMD HAS BEEN SUCCESSFUL



ENGAGEMENT WITH STRATEGIC HEALTH PARTNERS

- Relationship building with Health Providers
 - Contract with Bill Mueller
 - Engagement with Kaiser and Sutter has begun
 - First of its kind effort in CA
 - Intended to build on existing relationships through HHS
 - Initial meeting with Kaiser on 3/22
 - Topics included outreach to members and residents, coordination with health experts for advice
 - Will eventually expand to include UC Davis and Dignity Health



COORDINATION ON COUNTY LHMP

- 5-yr update of County's Local Hazard Mitigation Plan (LHMP)
- Identifies Hazards and Fundable Mitigation
- District providing hazards as annex to LHMP
 - Public education/outreach
 - Air quality sensors
 - Clean air center filtration
- LHMP to be submitted to FEMA for approval
