NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF RULE 102, DEFINITIONS

Placer County Air Pollution Control District (District) proposes to amend Rule 102, Definitions. The amendment updates the list of exempt volatile organic compounds to be consistent with that of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

The District Board of Directors will hold a public hearing regarding the Rule 102 amendment at its next scheduled regular meeting on June 11, 2020, starting at 2:30 PM. See below regarding public participation procedures due to COVID-19 concerns.
