



## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING PLACER COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT FISCAL YEAR 2020-21 PROPOSED BUDGET

**A public hearing will be held beginning at 2:30 P.M., Thursday, June 11, 2020**, before the Board of Directors of the Placer County Air Pollution Control District (District) for the exclusive purpose of reviewing the proposed District budget for fiscal year 2020-21 and providing the public with an opportunity to comment. The public hearing is the first to be held pursuant to Section 40131 of the California Health and Safety Code.

**A second public hearing** will be held before the Board of Directors to consider the approval of the final proposed budget on **Thursday, August 13, 2020**, at a regularly scheduled meeting, beginning at 2:30 P.M.

A summary of the proposed District budget for fiscal year 2020-21 may be reviewed after June 1, 2020. Copies of the proposed budget for fiscal year 2020-21 and the schedule of District fees, which are proposed to remain unchanged from FY 19-20, will be provided upon request or can be downloaded from <http://www.placerair.org>. ### **Public participation procedures due to COVID-19 concerns:**

Public participation is encouraged at these public hearings, but in order to protect public health and safety due to potential continued concerns regarding COVID-19, the public may not be able to attend in person. The Placer County Board of Supervisors Chambers, where the District's Board meetings are normally held, may be closed to public attendance to comply with physical distancing guidelines. In accordance with Governor Newsom's Executive Order N-29-20, citizens who wish to comment or listen to the meetings should be prepared to do so via a dial in phone number or via a remote online teleconference.
