These are vouchered programs where participants pay up to 30% of their income towards their housing. The target population and eligibility requirements are: Placer County residents who are chronically homeless AND have a documented disability.

Transitional & Permanent Housing Programs

CASA DEWITT HOUSING PROGRAM (Transitional/Bridge)

11523 C Avenue, Auburn, CA 95603

Casa Dewitt is a structured, supportive program for homeless individuals with a documented disability. Its goal is directed toward sustaining permanent housing. Individuals spend 15-20 hours per week developing the skills needed to maintain permanent housing, obtaining employment that pays a living wage, and live independently. It is not intended as permanent, subsidized housing. There are two program components:

Transitional Housing is a long term (up to 24 months) temporary housing opportunity to house homeless individuals in preparing them for housing placement with an intensive supportive network of care.

Bridge Housing is a short term (up to 90 days) temporary housing opportunity to house homeless individuals waiting on permanent placement. They are holders of a voucher (COC HUD, VASH, or Housing Choice (HCV)) and connected with a housing coordinator.

AMIH/ASOC Transitional and Permanent Housing Programs

Placer County Adult System of Care Welcome Center

11512B Avenue, Auburn, CA

The ASOC Transitional Housing Program works in collaboration with Advocates for Mentally Ill Housing (AMIH) to provide a safe and stable housing environment for its participants. Individuals reside in a group living situation and participate in both, independent and group activities, that promote independent living skills toward self-sufficiency. Food, basic utilities, bus tickets are included in the program fees. The target population and eligibility requirements are: Placer County individuals with a mental illness. Program fees range from \$425-\$615 per month. A limited number of subsidies may be available for those who qualify. There are four homes between Roseville and Auburn. Peer Supportive Transitional Housing (PSTH)

The target population and eligibility requirements are: Placer County individuals with a mental illness who are not linked to any direct services or case management. This program is similar to transitional housing, except it is led by peers who have lived experience and promote recovery. Staff is on-site daily to support and link residents to services within the community. There is no requirement of income upon entry to this program.

MHSA Transitional Housing Programs

There are two (2) ASOC MHSA Transitional Housing Programs. These programs require a referral from a case manager. Housing duration is limited to up to two years. MHSA funding may be available, on a case by case basis, to augment program fees for residents with limited income. The target population for these programs is as follows: individuals who are homeless or at risk of homelessness AND have a severe mental illness.(SMI) Eligibility requirements are: Placer County residents enrolled with the ASOC or Turning Point Full Service Partnership Programs.

MHSA Permanent Supportive Housing

There are two (2) ASOC MHSA Permanent Supportive Housing Programs. These housing programs require a referral from a case manager. Program fees are based on the resident's income. The target populations : for these programs is as follows: individuals who are homeless or at risk of homelessness AND have a severe mental illness (SMI). Eligibility requirements are: Placer County residents enrolled with the ASOC or Turning Point Full Service Partnership Programs

The Lazarus Project

The Lazarus Project provides supportive housing for homeless or at-risk of becoming homeless men and women from Placer County. The Lazarus Project offers individual rooms at their three men's residential homes and shared rooms at their woman's residential home all located in the Roseville area. Program costs are \$425 per month and include housing, case management, utilities, internet, cable television, and phone. To be eligible for the program you must be homeless or precariously housed, extremely low Income, currently residing in, working in or have immediate family that currently live in Placer County, individual man or woman and over 21 years of age.

A Case Manager helps veterans and their families access financial, health, transportation and other resources. An Employment Specialist helps vets and spouses find and keep a job. Residents must be drug and alcohol free for a minimum of 30 days. Stay is for up to 6 months. Residents are required to attend drug and alcohol treatment through CoRR's outpatient groups, two 12-step meetings per week, and be actively seeking employment. They must provide their own food, toiletries, linens, and cleaning supplies. Cost is \$600/month
